Order Reinstating James Sheehan's License to Practice Architecture

On August 14, 2025, the West Virginia Board of Architects ("Board") held a public meeting to consider James A. Sheehan's request for reconsideration of the Board's Order of June 9, 2025, denying Mr. Sheehan's reinstatement application. Currently, Mr. Sheehan is precluded from practicing architecture in West Virginia as defined in West Virginia Code § 30-12-2(5).

Based on Mr. Sheehan's statements and based on the Board's review of Mr. Sheehan's continuing education history, the Board hereby ORDERS and DECREES as follows:

Mr. Sheehan, by affixing his signature to this Order, agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Board shall reinstate Mr. Sheehan's license or registration upon Mr. Sheehan completing the following within 30 days of entry of this Order:
 - a. Mr. Sheehan shall pay a reinstatement fee of \$250.00 as first identified and set forth in the Consent Agreement and Order entered January 28, 2025.
 - b. Mr. Sheehan shall pay a penalty of \$3,000 as first identified and set forth in the Consent Agreement and Order entered January 28, 2025; and
 - c. Mr. Sheehan shall reimburse the Board for administrative expenses and reasonable attorney fees incurred by the Board in the review and disposition of this matter in the amount of \$1,200.

2. Mr. Sheehan understands and agrees that if fails to comply with the terms and conditions of this Order, his license or registration to practice architecture in West Virginia will not be reinstated and he shall be precluded from seeking renewal for three (3) years.

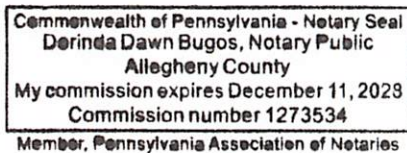
